## **Huonville's Million Paws Walk**

The RSPCA Million Paws Walk (MPW) is on again in Huonville on **Sunday 15 May 2016.** It is one of the major fundraising events for the RSPCA and involves thousands of people and dogs registering, fundraising and participating in walks held across Australia to raise money for those less fortunate animals in our care.

Huonville's events start at the Huonville Recreation Grounds (Wilmot Road & Tennis Court Road) and feature three walks to cater for the wide range of people and pooches participating. Registrations open at 10am and the walks start at 11am.

There's a **small walk** around the Oval - 400m, for little dogs and the elderly. The **medium walk** is to the Village Green and return – approximately 3km, on a level walking track. The **country walk** is through Skinners Track and returning - approximately 3.5km walk which incorporates the Skinners Track boardwalk.
