IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- * Under section 50 of the *Dog Control Act 2000 (the Act)* a person must not keep or allow to be kept on any premises, without a licence, more than 2 dogs over the age of 6 months; or more than 4 working dogs over the age of 6 months. A working dog means a dog used principally for droving or tending livestock; or detecting illegal substances; or searching, tracking or rescuing; or working with police officers. A 'Licence to Keep Dogs' application form may be obtained from our website www.huonvalley.tas.gov.au or from the Council office.
- ** Under section 6 of the *Act* the owner of a dog is taken to be:
 - (a) in the case of a registered dog, the person in whose name the dog is registered; or
 - (b) in the case of an unregistered dog, the person who ordinarily keeps the dog; or
 - (c) in the case of a child's pet, the child's parent or guardian.
- *** If the dog has been notified under section 30 of the *Act* as a guard dog used to guard premises that are not residential, the address of the premises guarded by the dog is to be notified.
- Guide Dog/Hearing Dog as defined by the Guide Dogs and Hearing Dogs Act 1967
Assistance Dog as defined by the Disability Discrimination Act 1992
- Discounted fees apply until 5:00pm 31 July. The full registration fee will apply thereafter.
- All dogs over the age of 6 months must be registered and microchipped pursuant to sections 8 & 15A of the *Act*. The owner of an unregistered or unmicrochipped dog over the age of 6 months is guilty of an offence and is liable for prosecution in accordance with the provisions of the *Act*.
- Owners seeking concessional registration (ie Sterilised, Greyhounds and Pensioners) may need to produce written evidence of eligibility as prescribed in the *Act*.
- Breeders must produce a current Stud Prefix issued by the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc.
