Have your say on the Huonville-Ranelagh Master Plan

The Huon Valley Council (HVC) invites your input into the Huonville-Ranelagh Master Plan.

HVC Commissioner Adriana Taylor says HVC has appointed planning consultants **Emma Riley & Associates and SGS** to prepare a Master Plan for Huonville-Ranelagh.

“The Master Plan will provide a comprehensive integrated framework for future development and investment in Huonville and Ranelagh for the next 15-20 years.

“The Master Plan aims to not only guide the long-term growth of the towns, but contribute to their increased activity.

“The process of preparing the Master Plan begins with understanding the issues, what’s important about it and what the community values are. There are three ways to become involved, a workshop, two drop-in sessions and an online survey.

“The workshop on **Tuesday 5 December** in the Huonville Town Hall from 4-7pm, will involve business, community and government stakeholders working together around a table to identify issues and opportunities for the townships. You can register for the workshop by **Thursday 30 November**.

“When you register please identify your interest in the Master Plan (i.e. business owner, community group representative or community member). Refreshments will be provided.

“The drop-in sessions in Huonville 9.30-11.30am (40 Main Street side entrance) and Ranelagh 12.30-2.30pm (Memorial Hall) are both on **Saturday 9 December**. They are informal and people can stay for 5 minutes or the entire time to discuss ideas and opportunities for the townships.

“If you can’t make the workshop or drop-in sessions, you will still be able to provide your feedback via an online survey, which will be available for a 2-week period from the **27 November until the 11 December 2017**,” Commissioner Taylor said.
