## Learn how to support someone impacted by suicide

The Huon Valley Council is holding community information sessions during the month of January about how to support someone impacted by suicide. Huon Valley Council Mayor Bec Enders says the sessions aim to increase community members understanding of suicide bereavement and learn basic support skills.

The Information sessions will be conducted by Standby Support after Suicide in partnership with Lifeline Tasmania. StandBy - Support after Suicide is a community-based suicide postvention program, providing a coordinated response of support and assistance for people who have been exposed to, or bereaved through suicide.

Suicide is a time of immense crisis and the tragedy of suicide loss can create trauma – deeply affecting individuals, families and entire communities.

"These information sessions are important events on the Huon Valley events calendar, Cr Enders said". In many cases those bereaved by suicide do not know where to turn for help or how to find support that may already exist. The StandBy service provides a reliable, single point of contact coordinating existing services to enable an immediate response.

People can receive face-to-face support provided by skilled StandBy crisis response team members, and referral to a centrally coordinated system of local support services matched to their needs. StandBy also responds to school settings, workplaces, community groups and other types of multiple bereavement experiences.

"Suicide can impact people in very different ways. Losing someone to suicide can be overwhelming and confusing and can present a wide range of emotions. I invite all community members to attend one of the following sessions Cr Enders said:
