Have Your Say: The future of Ranelagh Recreation ground

The future of the Ranelagh Recreation grounds will be shaped in coming weeks after Huon Valley Council appointed consultants to help draft a master plan for the grounds.

The grounds will play a key role in council's ten year recreation strategy for the region.

Council has appointed consultants Inspiring Place to help develop a plan for the area and the community is being asked to share ideas about the future of this important site.

Mayor Bec Enders encourages anyone who enjoys events at the Ranelagh Recreation Ground to have their say on the site's future.

"This is an important site for the whole region hosting some of our biggest events including the Huon Show, the Taste of the Huon, Small Farms Expo and, for the first time this year, the Huon Valley Mid-Winter Fest," she said.

"It accommodates these events on top of its regular usage as a cricket field and local dog walking area.

"We want to hear from as many residents as possible about what they think should happen to the ground in the coming decade. It is important that we hear from people of all ages and people with different levels of mobility.

We know that our residents have so many different experiences to draw upon that would help increase the activity level of the grounds and add to the vibrancy of living in the Huon Valley". Please make a note in your diary to attend a community workshop, held with the consultants at the ground on Sunday 26 May between 9 and 3:30pm.
