



Pitch and Vote Overview

Purpose

The Huonville Pitch and Vote is an informal, fun and collaborative process to create an even better Huonville. It empowers local people to make the decision on which project gets funding.

How it Works

- Everyone is welcome to attend the Huonville Pitch and Vote social event and dinner.
- Four shortlisted people/groups with project ideas to improve the Huonville town centre/ community will make their pitch to receive up to \$1,500 in funding for their project.
- Over a shared dinner, attendees cast their vote for the project they want to help fund.
- Winners come back to a future event to tell us about how the project went.

Principles (what we are trying to achieve)

- Creating an even better Huonville
- Local action by local people
- Creating connections
- A more active and attractive place
- A more resilient and sustainable place

Shortlisting Assessment Criteria

This is a public call out for project ideas. A quick shortlisting process through Huon Valley Council will then select four projects for the event. The assessment criteria for shortlisting the projects are:

1. Alignment with purpose and principles

How well does the project align with the purpose and principles?

2. Community Building

How does the project empower and/or connect local residents and businesses?

3. Viability

Every idea is great, but some projects have a better chance of success. How will the project be delivered and by whom? The aim is that every project can be completed within 3 months of receiving approval at the community event. Is this realistic and achievable with the project proposed?

4. Resilience

Is the project temporary or permanent? If it is intended to be around for a period of time, how will it be managed and by whom? Does it help to make Huonville more resilient?

Remember, this your project and you are responsible for making it happen. **Closing date for projects is 12 April 2021**
