General Managers Annual Performance Review

The General Manager's Annual Performance Review outcome was resolved in a closed Huon Valley Council meeting last month.

Acting Mayor Sally Doyle said the performance of the General Manager, Jason Browne, has been satisfactory based on the score of 6 out of 10.

Acting Mayor Doyle highlighted the following achievements for the Huon Valley community since the general manager took on the role in September 2021:

- Allocation of \$0.9 million in additional funding for the Huon Valley's road network
- Investment of \$674,000 to strategic land use planning
- Confirmation of \$1.625 million in funding over three years for the Huon Valley Jobs initiative
- Adoption of the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy
- Maintaining the health and safety of the community, customers and staff from the continuing impacts of COVID-19.

The general manager's remuneration package has also been reviewed and has been indexed at 6.5 per cent in line with the consumer price index and in accordance with advice from Blackadder Associates, the consultant facilitating the annual performance review process.

Acting Mayor Doyle said the General Manager's Performance Review Committee will consider and advise the council of the 2022-23 projects and priorities adopted for the general manager.

"Specific measures and key performance indicators will be built into the next performance agreement to enable council to objectively measure performance in the next review period."

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
