Port Huon Pool to be closed for major refurbishment

The Huon Valley Council wishes to advise the Port Huon Pool will be closed for at least two months while it undergoes a major refurbishment.

Re-lining works on the pool are expected to start in August 2023 and continue for two to three months.

During this time, the pool will be closed.

Other facilities in the Port Huon Sports Centre, such as the gym and playing courts, will remain open.

On Time Developments has been awarded the project tender, with works to include lining the pool with new tiles to provide better durability, lower maintenance requirements and a longer life.

The project is the first of a planned series of service improvements to the facility.

Gym equipment, operating hours, access and the management of payments and memberships are also being reviewed.

Council appreciates the patience of PHSC users during this time and will keep the community informed.

“We understand the temporary pool closure will be disappointing for some and an inconvenience,” said Mayor Sally Doyle.

“But we look forward to the enhancement of this important community facility, to better meet the needs of the future.”
